Tournament Security Policy

Parking

- Controlled traffic flow in & out of complex. (Volunteers and Security)
- Monitor parking areas for pedestrian safety. (Volunteers)
- Use of 2-way radios to ensure above.

Grounds

- Ensure all goals are anchored and secured.
- Inspect all nets.
- Goals not being used must be put in a safe place away from playing area and also anchored and secured.
- All vendors must have their equipment secure & inspected before tournament begins by Tournament Director.
- Adequate restroom facilities.
- All spectators' bleachers & team benches must be placed in a safe area appropriately from the sideline, at least 3 feet from touch line.
- Inspect all fields before, during for foreign objects and check for holes or ruts.
- If teams use portable tents to put over bench it must be securely anchored.

Medical

Medical Trainers to be provided by Forte. Trainers are all certified & shall meet the following criteria:

- Trained and equipped to treat trauma and perform CPR.
- Provide emergency first aid.
- Recognize and treat sport related injuries.
- Maintain communications with tournament HQ and EMS services.
- Medics Identifiable (Badge/Clothing)
- Provide written directions to local medical facilities or hospitals.
- Provide written report to tournament for each transported player.

Player/Coach Parent

- If player/coach/parent is ejected they must leave the facility.
- They will be escorted away from the field by the field marshal, tournament official and referee assignor.
- If any person(s) is unwilling to leave, police assistance will be asked for and enforced.

Personnel

- Tournament Officials: All staff in identifying apparel with 2-way radios.
- Field Marshals: 1 per 2 fields with 2-way radios.
- Police: Onsite during event hours.
